

Conditions of Entry

The Y WA is committed to ensuring a child-safe environment for all children and young people

1. Observe and follow all signs and instructions from Y staff. They are in place for your safety and comfort.
2. Comply with all relevant laws and regulations.
3. The use, possession, or influence of illegal drugs/alcohol, smoking or vaping substances/devices is not permitted within our premises and persons must not supply alcohol or drugs to children and young people in accordance with our Drug and Alcohol Policy.
4. Violence, disruptive, offensive behaviour or language will not be tolerated at the Y WA. No weapons of any sort are allowed to be brought to the Y.
5. The Y WA conducts visual bag checks.
6. Respect the rights and diverse needs of all children and young people in line with our Safeguarding Children and Young People Policy and procedures. Do not make derogatory, culturally insensitive, or other inappropriate comments whilst at the Y WA.
7. Provide the Y WA with all required information including any requests for identification, insurance information or other information as necessary.
8. Only Y Devices may be used to record or take appropriate images of children and young people where programming permits and consent has been obtained. The exception may be recreation spaces where in limited circumstances personal electronic devices may be used by participants to record or take images if all relevant individuals have provided the appropriate consent to take and use images. The use of personal devices (e.g. mobile phones, tablets, cameras, wearables) is prohibited in all change rooms and toilets.
9. All areas of the Service are monitored regularly by our Y People. If you become aware of any incidents or safety concerns promptly report them to a Y staff member.
10. By entering our premises, you consent to these Conditions of Entry.

The Y WA wants everyone to enjoy a safe environment. Individuals may be excluded from participating in programs and services if they are adversely affected by alcohol or drugs or if they demonstrate inappropriate and unacceptable standards of behaviour that contravene the Y WA's Code of Conduct. Any unsafe and unacceptable behaviour may result in reporting to relevant government agencies as required by law.
