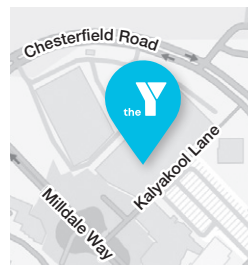

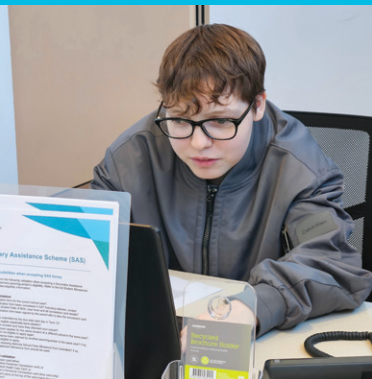


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The Y WA

The Y School

At the Y School, we believe the Science of Learning tells us how students learn effectively. The staff at the Y School understand that they are responsible for providing a high-quality learning experience for all students.

Students who have previously experienced difficulty in accessing school may choose to enrol and engage in their learning in a place where everyone can belong and overcome previous challenges, through dedicated support and accessible curriculum.

What we do differently

From the very start of a student's journey with The Y School, the team seek to support them and their individual needs in a way that allows them to find success. Individual Education Plans are meticulously designed and implemented, including information on how we will assist young people, both academically and in a social & emotional context, consistently creating a focus on mastery of essential skills through educational success and competence.

The high-quality teaching of both Direct Instruction Literacy & Numeracy, as well as STEAM classes, enables students to progress academically in a fully supported manner. We focus on the provision opportunities for students to flourish, through improved educational outcomes, academic mastery and psychosocial development.

Our team recognise that connection and a sense of belonging are central to the educational success of our students. They develop professional relationships with our students and all major stakeholders to assist in the mapping of academic goals, to build and strengthen individual characters, to create flourishing opportunities in the future, so that students can be confident in their roles as positive members of their communities.



Our Curriculum

For our Year 7, 8 & 9 students, we offer:

- ▶ Direct Instruction Literacy & Numeracy - focussed instruction, working with students at their level, providing opportunity for significant improvement and confidence building.
- ▶ STEAM - A combination of Science, Technology, English, Art & Maths (and other WA Curriculum subjects), allowing students to explore topics in an accessible and student-centred way.
- ▶ Curriculum designed to help develop skills in wellbeing, community & cultural connection and pro-social behaviours.
- ▶ Positive Youth Development sessions, supporting students in life skills and proactive behaviours.

The Y School Culture

The Y School fosters connection and belonging, where all differences, genders, sexualities, cultures, religions and backgrounds are acknowledged and accepted and celebrated.

We have developed a connected culture that is safe, nurturing and inclusive. Our staff take responsibility for the learning and engagement of every student at our school. Our students want to learn and make a decision to enrol at our school and to engage. We seek to support our students develop confidence and character in a caring school environment.

Our dedicated team, including Teachers, Youth Workers, Education Assistants, School Counsellors and administrative staff provide additional layers of support for students with specific needs, collaborating with all stakeholders to address disabilities, physical and mental health conditions.
